

Songs: Vehadi

- **Explanation of the Songs “Vehadi” and “Venir Benir”**
- Just a bit of an explanation about the first two songs — *Vehadi* and *Venir Benir*.
- They are not in Bulgarian but in a sacred language that the Master intuitively connected with, known as **Vatan**.
- The Master Beinsa Douno explained:
- **Vehadi** expresses a quality of the Spirit. It comes from the depths of the soul, from within.
He said: “If you knew the language of the angels, I would say to you *Vehadi*. In this word, the Spirit is opening. *Hadi* means the beginning of some work.”
It is a sacred word from the language of the soul.

Venir Benir

- **Venir Benir** comes from the East and carries a mystical meaning. It means:
“Thou, Great One, who blesses everything.”
- Other words within the song have these meanings:
- **Bihar benum** – to be blessed.
- **Il biyut** – God, bless the great, the youth, the beginning of life.
- **Il bezut**, – God blesses the young who are entering the divine life; blesses the divine essence that is being conceived in the soul — the breath of God that we received in the beginning.
- **Om biyut**: – He, God, who is alone — the One who blesses.
- **Bil Bursut Ombiyut** – He is everything; He is everywhere; He is all our life.
- **Binom Tu meto** – Now, let it be. Let it now be so! And man became a living soul!
- This expresses the relationship between the Great and the small — between God and the soul.
The small is filled with great thoughts about God.
The soul remembers the moment when she received the first breath of life from God.
